REPUBLICAN RUNNING-MATE ANNOUNCED

Mark Belz, representing Republican Presidential Nominee Barry Goldwater in the campus campaign here beginning today, has officially announced the selection of freshman Edward V. Dengler as his running-mate to represent vice-presidential nominee William B. Miller. Both Belz and Dengler are Iowans, and Dengler has been working closely with Belz on the organization of the entire campaign.

Generally, the announcement of this selection surprised few. Dengler, like Belz, represents that strong-flavored midwestern Goldwater conservatism.

Both candidates will speak in behalf of their respective counterparts at tonight's rally. Mark "Goldwater" Belz is delivering what is termed a major policy speech. The rally is scheduled for 9:30 P.M.
